



## WTS Will Kempton High School Scholarship

WTS fosters the development of women and girls in the transportation field by encouraging bright new professionals and students to undertake careers in the area of transportation. One way it does this is by awarding scholarships to girls pursuing high school studies in science, technology, engineering, and math.

The WTS Sacramento Chapter Will Kempton High School Scholarship is available to a female high school senior in the Sacramento Region who is inspired to pursue a college degree in a transportation-related field, including studies in engineering, math, architecture, geography, business, law, political science, environmental science, planning, economics, sociology, and government policy. The scholarship is named for the former Director of the California Department of Transportation who serves as a strong advocate for WTS and the importance of education.

At the national level, the WTS Transportation YOU High School Scholarship is awarded for \$1,000. The application of the local recipient is forwarded for entrance in the international scholarship selection process. The WTS Sacramento Chapter Will Kempton High School Scholarship is \$2,000. The minimum criteria for selection are:

- a. Applicant must be a high school senior.
- b. GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- c. Currently studying math, science, and technology.
- d. Considering a college degree in a transportation-related field

Each application must be submitted through local WTS chapters as a typed **PDF**. Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills. National awards will be presented during the WTS Annual Conference on May 14, 2020, and attendance at the awards dinner is strongly recommended. **The scholarship recipient will receive \$2,000 at our WTS Sacramento Annual Awards and Scholarship dinner on January 28, 2020.**
